◀ Today Native Americans live in simple but modern houses*. At pow wows, they sleep* in traditional tents called "teepees".

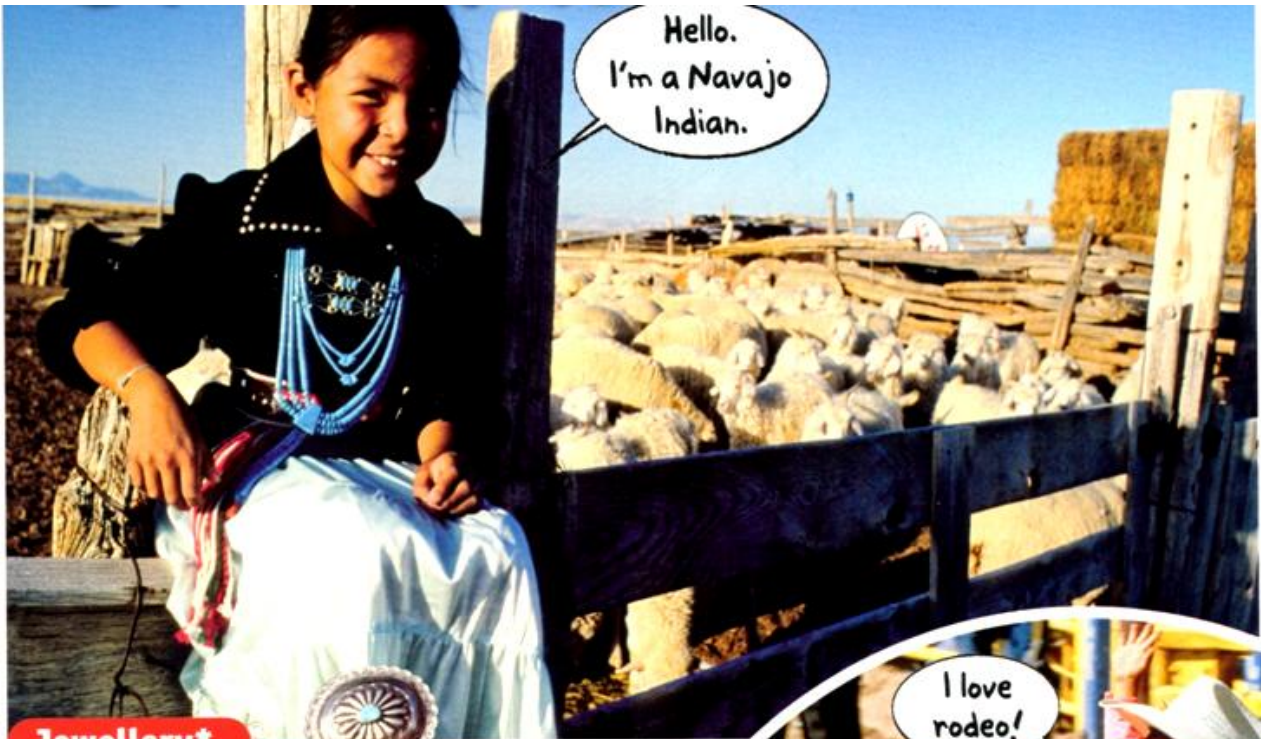
houses: maisons

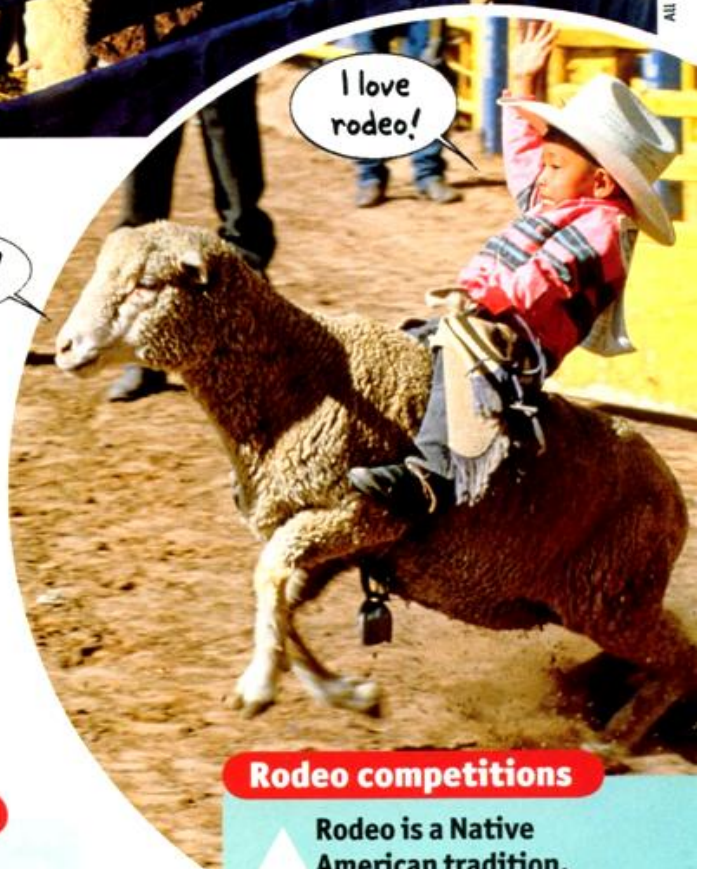
Jewellery*

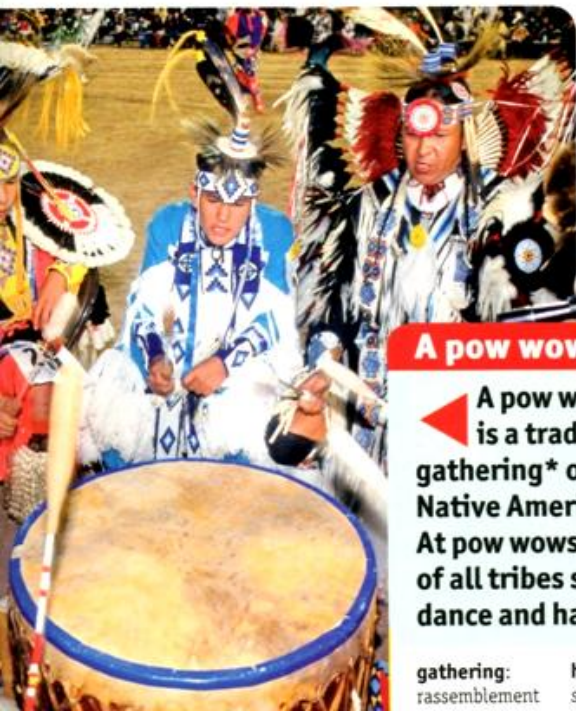
